

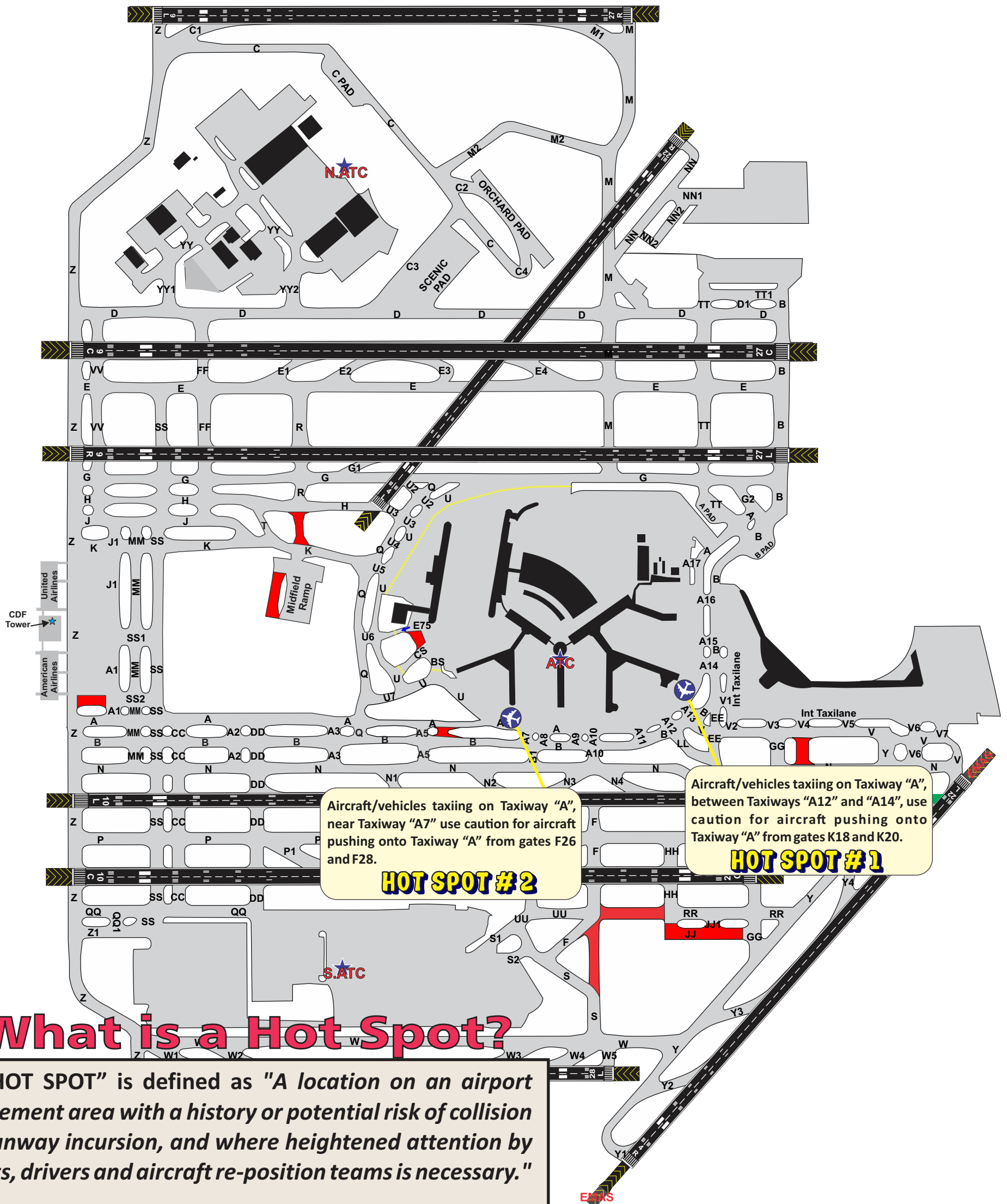
Hot Spot Airfield Map

Aircraft/vehicles taxiing on Taxiway "A", near Taxiway "A7" use caution for aircraft pushing onto Taxiway "A" from gates F26 and F28.

HOT SPOT #2

Aircraft/vehicles taxiing on Taxiway "A", between Taxiways "A12" and "A14", use caution for aircraft pushing onto Taxiway "A" from gates K18 and K20.

HOT SPOT #1

What is a Hot Spot?

A "HOT SPOT" is defined as "A location on an airport movement area with a history or potential risk of collision or runway incursion, and where heightened attention by pilots, drivers and aircraft re-position teams is necessary."

By identifying hot spots, it is easier for users of an airport to plan the safest possible path of movement in and around that airport. Planning is a crucial safety activity for airport users.
